## GOLF PROFESSIONAL

It seemed to me that the wind blew the entire month of April but we still had a great Masters Member Tournament on April 8. In the Gross division Tim Dolan was 5th with 80, Jim Largent was 4th with 80, Dustin Anderson was 3rd with 75, Tucker Allen was 2nd with 73 and Eric Anderson was 1st with 73. In the Net division Rob McDonald was 9th with 70, Wes Jones was 8th with 70, Roger Blackwelder was 7th with 69, Tony Varnell was 6th with 69, Rick Karnuth 5th with 69, Kevin Floroplus 4th with 69, Jimmy Garcia 3rd with 68, Larry Whittet was 2nd with 66 and the winner was Tony Reeves with a 66. We had 42 participants and included Skins, Closest to the Pin, and Pairing with a Masters player as other competitions. We held the NTPGA Junior All American two day tournament on April 22 and 23 and our own Dustin Anderson won the boys 15-18 age group in a 2 hole playoff. We host the All American Tour again in September.

Upcoming in May we have another Member Tournament on Sunday May 7th at 1pm. This is a 2 person Team Event and if you don't have a partner we will be glad to pair up golfers to form a team. ## TURF TALK

It looks like we are finally going to start seeing some temperatures that are "normal" for this time of the year! I use that loosely because we all know Texas weather is never the same from one year to the next! We need to have daytime temperatures at least in the upper 80's and night time temperatures in the upper 60's before the bermudagrass really starts to wake up and thrive. I am trying to not to be too impatient because those dreaded triple digits will get here soon enough! All in all the golf course is in great shape considering the moderate temperatures we have had this spring. As it starts to get warmer, our maintenance practice will begin to get more routine and our mowing schedules will be more consistent. As part of kicking off the growing season, we have our first greens aerification scheduled for May 15. I know this process is not a favorite for many, but it is a necessary evil that helps set the stage for the health of the greens, by reducing compaction; and increasing water, nutrient, and air movement in the soil. This in turn help promote a stronger root system which gives the plant the strength it need to make it through the Texas summer!
